



Thanks again for your interest in the ePoster exhibition of the International Osteology Symposium Vienna and congratulations on the acceptance of your ePoster abstract!

It is time to submit your final ePoster for the International Osteology Symposium 2026. We are pleased to announce that the upload service is now available until Wednesday, 15 April 2026.

We kindly ask you to design and upload your final ePoster that you will show or present orally during the symposium in the coming weeks. We look forward to your final submission and presentation of your original research work from 23-25 April 2026.

Deadlines

The deadline for submitting/uploading your final ePoster is **15 April 2026, 23:59 CET**. Please note that late submissions will not be considered unless a deadline extension is formally announced by the Osteology Foundation.

ePoster submission system

The ePoster must be exclusively submitted through the online submission system (provided by documediaS). Multiple submissions of the same author are allowed but must have different topics. The following link will guide you to the login of the submission system:

Kindly follow these instructions to submit your ePoster in three steps:

1. Use the "Upload your ePoster" section to upload your "static" ePoster slide.
2. Use the "Consent" section to provide the requested information.
3. Submit your ePoster (and videos).

You may replace a submitted ePoster or video, as long as you do it before the submission deadline. You will receive a confirmation email after you submit the ePoster.

ePoster format

- Every author of an accepted ePoster abstract is notified via E-mail with instructions on how to upload the final ePoster (access code etc.)
- The ePoster needs to match the following requirements:
 - Number of pages: 1
 - File format: PPT, PPTX, or PDF
 - Poster ratio: 16:9
 - Poster orientation: **Landscape**
 - Screen size: 60" (135 cm width x 75 cm height or 1920x1080 pixels) – your ePoster will scale automatically to the screen size. For convenience you might use the linked PPT template below.
 - If the ePoster includes video material, it must be uploaded separately. The following requirements apply:
 - Video and file format: .mp4
 - Max. duration: 1 minute
 - Max. number: 1 video
 - Sound: not supported
- Please feel free to design your ePoster as you see fit, as long as it respects the requirements indicated above. An ePoster template is available at: [PPT ePoster Template](#)
- Illustrations and text must be readable from a distance of at least 1.5 meters. ePoster titles should include the full title (NO UPPER CASE TITLE), authors (without academic title) and their institutional affiliations.
- The ePoster presented at the symposium must cover the same topic as the ePoster abstract.
- All posters will be displayed digitally. There is NO need to print the ePoster.

ePoster presentation

All ePosters will be on display during the second and third day of the symposium. To enhance the scientific exchange, first authors shall be close to their ePosters during lunch and coffee breaks and be prepared for Q&A by any interested symposium participant.

Oral ePoster presentations will take place on **Friday, 24 April 2026 from 10:45 – 11:15 and 15:45 – 16:15. See details of presenters and topics on our website.** The first authors of the three highest ranked ePoster abstracts in each category will present orally for 5 minutes (plus 2 minutes for Q&A). The categories are:

Please note, that the Osteology Foundation reserves the right to reallocate to another category. In this case, the corresponding author will be notified via email.

Awards

A jury for each category, consisting of two scientific committee members, will evaluate the three presenters in each category on-site and will award a prize of € 500 to the best (only for 1st place) presenter in each category on the following symposium day. In total, six prizes will be awarded in recognition of the best work in all submission categories.

The award winners will be selected based on both their ePoster and their oral ePoster presentation during the symposium.

The award ceremony will take place on the final day of the symposium (25 April 2026, 11:15-11:30 CET). Winners will be required to come on stage to receive their prize. We ask all presenting authors to be in the main auditorium during the award ceremony.

Affirmations

In addition to the affirmations given during ePoster abstract submission, you affirm the following statements:

- I understand that the ePoster abstract and ePoster presentation language is English.
- I affirm that the submitted ePoster contains work that is original and has not been previously published in a journal.
- The submitting author confirms that all listed co-authors are aware that their names will appear on the final ePoster and that they have approved the submission.
- I understand that if this ePoster is submitted/uploaded, Osteology Foundation will hold the copyright.
- I agree that the Osteology Foundation reserves the right to do additional language editing before publishing the ePoster online. The edited version will not be sent to the authors prior to the online publishing.
- For clinical studies and animal studies, I certify that the study has been approved by an appropriate Institutional Research Board/ Research Ethics Committee and is compliant with applicable ethical guidelines.
- I affirm that if this ePoster is submitted, at least one of the authors will register for the International Osteology Symposium in Vienna.
- I affirm that I will also present my ePoster if the session is arranged in a hybrid format.
