



General information

Thanks for your interest in the e-poster exhibition of the International Osteology Symposium Vienna! We warmly invite you to submit your e-poster abstract for consideration in either the general e-poster exhibition, the Research Networking Day or both. We look forward to the submission and presentation of your original research work at this prestigious event that will take place from 23-25 April 2026.

All e-poster abstracts on oral tissue regeneration are welcome, whether they focus on clinical or preclinical research. Please note that abstracts shall not contain any published data at the time of submission.

All accepted e-poster abstracts and e-posters may be published online on the submission platform, and the respective e-posters will be exhibited and presented onsite during the symposium. Prizes for the best oral e-poster presentation (1st place) in each of the six submission categories will be awarded.

Deadlines

The deadline for submitting an e-poster abstract is **1 December 2025**, **23:59 CET**. Please note that late submissions will not be considered unless a deadline extension is formally announced by the Osteology Foundation.

The applicants will be notified via e-mail whether their e-poster abstracts are accepted or rejected by 30 January 2026. All first authors of accepted e-poster abstracts must register for the symposium by 15 February 2026. All first authors of accepted abstracts will be required to present their work during the second day (24 April 2026) of the symposium. Awards will be presented during the last day (25 April 2026) of the symposium.

e-poster abstract submission system

The e-poster abstracts must be exclusively submitted through the online submission system (provided by documediaS). Multiple submissions of the same author are allowed but must have different topics. 1. Abstract body

Type selection

Please select here if you like to compete with your e-poster abstract for participation in the Research Networking Day, for oral e-poster presentations or just a usual e-poster presentation during the symposium. The 20 best e-poster abstracts submitted will receive an invitation to participate in the Research Networking Day. Please select here the category into which you believe your e-poster abstract will fit best. The submission categories are:

- Soft Tissue Regeneration
- Periodontal Regeneration,

Please note, that the Osteology Foundation reserves the right to reallocate to another category. In this case, the corresponding author will be notified via email.

Please indicate if the nature of your research study is clinical or preclinical. For the submission of **case reports**, please select the option "clinical" and indicate "case report" clearly in your abstract title. You may also consider the Case Competition - Osteology Vienna.

Please enter the title of your e-poster abstract, which must not exceed 25 words. Please <u>do not</u> use UPPER CASE TITLE. Title Case Title or Sentence case title are allowed.

Abstract Text

Please enter the Aim, Material & Methods, Results and Conclusion of your research work. A maximum of 300 words is allowed. Tables and images are not allowed.

Conflict of Interest statement

Disclosures: You are required to indicate whether you have potential conflict of interest associated with the presentations: e.g., received a financial benefit, consultancy or other relationship with products, manufacturer(s) of products or providers of services or financial support related to the topic of the abstract. If yes, the potential conflict of interest/relationship needs to be reported in the abstract submission process.



2. Authors

Please indicate the author who will be the presenter of the e-poster. The author who will be selected as presenter will automatically become the first author. The submitting person, and if also deviating the presenting person, will receive information regarding acceptance/rejection, e-poster upload etc.

- The names and the entered order may be published online.
- Enter first and last name of all authors.
- Do not add academic titles.
- The names cannot be changed after submission.

3. Affirmation

In addition to the affirmations given during e-poster abstract submission, you affirm the following statements:

- I understand that the e-poster abstract and e-poster presentation language is English.
- I affirm that the submitted e-poster abstract contains work that is original and has not been previously published in a journal.
- The submitting author confirms that all listed co-authors are aware that their names will appear on the abstract and that they have approved the abstract submission.
- I understand that if this e-poster abstract is accepted, Osteology Foundation will hold the copyright.
- By submitting an abstract on this website, I acknowledge that I own or otherwise have rights
 to the written summaries of research or observations ("Abstract") provided by me to Osteology
 Foundation, utilising this site.
- I agree that the Osteology Foundation reserves the right to do additional language editing before publishing the e-poster abstract online. The edited version will not be sent to the authors prior to the online publishing.
- In case of unsuccessfully applying for an oral e-poster presentation or participation in the Research Networking Day, I will accept a usual e-poster presentation.
- I affirm that if this e-poster abstract is accepted as an e-poster presentation, it will be submitted and presented as an e-poster following the general rules of electronic poster format preparation.
- For clinical studies and animal studies, I certify that the study has been approved by an appropriate Institutional Research Board/ Research Ethics Committee and is compliant with applicable ethical guidelines.
- I affirm that if this e-poster abstract is accepted for an e-poster or an oral e-poster presentation, at least one of the authors will register for the International Osteology Symposium in Vienna by the given deadline (15 February 2026).
- I affirm that I will also present my e-poster abstract if the session is arranged in a hybrid format.



4. Submit

During this final step, you can review your entered data and download your submission in PDF format. Authors can edit their e-poster abstracts after submission via the edit function available on the landing page of the online submission tool. After the submission deadline has passed, editing any submitted abstract will no longer be possible.

Evaluation & selection

- All e-poster abstracts will be reviewed by a jury of experts in their field. You can find them listed on the following website: e-Poster Exhibition Osteology Vienna
- Evaluation criteria are relevance for oral tissue regeneration, originality of hypothesis, methodology and clinical relevance.
- All first authors of accepted e-poster abstracts will be invited to display and present their e-poster during the e-poster session at the symposium.
- If the submitting author is unable to attend the symposium or to present their e-poster, they must notify the Osteology Foundation via e-mail (grants@osteology.org) as soon as possible and before the start of the symposium, to withdraw their abstract/e-poster. Any withdrawn submission cannot compete for the award. Alternatively, they may appoint a substitute presenter.

e-poster format

- The screen dimension is 60" in **landscape orientation**, which corresponds to 135 cm in width and 75 cm in height (resolution of 1920x1080 pixels).
- Illustrations and text must be readable from a distance of at least 1.5 meters. E-poster titles should include the full title (<u>NO</u> UPPER CASE TITLE), authors (without academic title) and their institutional affiliations.
- Please feel free to design your e-poster as you see fit, as long as it respects the requirements indicated above. There is no e-poster template available.
- The e-poster presented at the symposium must cover the same topic as the e-poster abstract.
- Your e-poster can only be uploaded in PowerPoint (ppt/pptx) or PDF format before the start of the symposium. The final e-poster is converted to PDF (no animations possible). One additional audio or video file can be uploaded to be shown next to your e-poster onsite.
- All posters will be displayed digitally. There is NO need to print the e-poster.

e-poster presentation

All e-posters will be on display during the second and third day of the symposium. To enhance the scientific exchange, first authors shall be close to their e-posters during lunch and coffee breaks and be prepared for Q&A by any interested symposium participant.

Oral e-poster presentations will take place on **Friday**, **24 April 2026 from 10:45 – 11:15 and 15:45 – 16:15.** After abstract submission and review by our scientific committee, the first authors of the three highest ranked e-poster abstracts will be invited to present orally for 5 minutes (plus 2 minutes for Q&A). A jury for each category, consisting of two scientific committee members, will evaluate the three presenters in each category on-site and will award a prize to the best presenter in each category on the following symposium day.



Awards

Six prizes will be awarded in recognition of the best works in all submission categories. Only one prize (1st place) per category will be awarded.

The award winners will be selected based on <u>both</u> their e-poster abstract submission and their onsite oral e-poster presentation during the symposium (please refer to the "Evaluation & Selection" section above). Those selected in 1st place will be awarded a prize of 500 €.

The award ceremony will take place on the final day of the symposium (25 April 2026, 11:15-11:30 CET). Winners will be required to come on stage to receive their prize.
